PRAYER MAP

Why should we spend time praying for other people?

- We have uninterrupted, unlimited access to the Father through Jesus. (1 John 2:1; Hebrews 7:25) What is an advocate? How is Jesus our advocate? How can we advocate for others?
- God wants us to approach Him. (Hebrews 4:16; Psalm 25:14)

 If you truly believed God wanted you to approach Him, how would that change your prayer life?
- The work of transforming people's lives is not difficult; it's impossible. (Matthew 19:26) When we try to do the work of God without prayer, what does that reveal about our heart?

God has a reason for where He has placed you. Who in your life can you impact for the sake of Christ? A prayer map keeps our mind focused on the people God has placed around us and reminds us to intercede for them every day.

Create Your Own Prayer Map

- 1. Begin by writing your name in the middle and drawing a circle around it.
- 2. Think of the contexts you have around you to meet other people. This could be things like: Class, Neighborhood/Dorm, Work, Church, Family, etc.
- 3. Write in names of people you know from each of these spheres. As you meet new people, keep adding them to the map.
- 4. Put this prayer map where you will see it often and start by praying for 2-3 people each day.
